Trustee's Report - Lisa Guderyan

We had 3 meetings related to the George Pringle opening and whether we want to keep things status quo (scenario 2/3) or maintain the decisions made in 2022 about moving Shannon lake from a CNB to a GMS feeder school (scenario 1). Initial decisions at the 3 engagements seems to be leaning towards scenario 3 which is essentially more strictly enforcing board policy on students being directed to their catchment school at transitions to correct the “catchment creep” that has developed over years of students attending out of catchment schools but any decisions on scenario 1,2 or 3 will likely occur in the fall once we have received survey results (see below for link to survey but it's the one that was sent this week from the school).

Other highlights:

- construction is progressing very well for a Sept 2027 opening of a dual track (English/french) school with grade 9/10s (current gr 7/8)
- 2028 will have gr9/10/11/ with first grad class being 2030
- Principal will be announced Jan 2027
- Course selection will occur in Feb 2027
- Course offerings at grade 9/10 are still mostly core academics but there will still be electives but which is yet to be determined but will be decided with input from parents, other secondary principals/
- Academies are run by teachers generally and need to be approved by PACs which cant officially be started until the school is opened but leg work, reaching out to potential community sponsors, etc can start anytime)
- All secondary schools across the district have aligned timetables which allows for cross enrolment (ie a student could be enrolled at Pringle and attend an elective or academy at MBSS)
- Sports teams are bit different and are regulated by BC school sports but there may be opportunities to play at MBSS until Pringle's population can support a team but that would be evaluated on a case-by-case basis by BC school sports.
