Food Safe Renewal

Emma Webber led in hosting a table at the community Bake Sale on February 15 at the Visitor's Centre, donating her time and a large quantity of baking sold. Although the clientele was not necessarily ideal, PAC still managed to raise approximately \$350 from the event and gained some visibility for our group in the community.

Rotary Presentation

Leath Strench and Kristen Friesen presented to the Rotary Club in behalf of the PAC to propose fundraising support for the playground, and to build positive relations with the organization. The opportunity proved to be a success, with a great reception from the group and positive feedback regarding potential support. More discussions are expected in the future.

PAC Positions

PAC positions remain open for next year, and advertising to the parent community will need to be done before the end of the year to promote these.

Hip Hop Classes

Hip Hop Classes were a great success, and the feedback from the students was very positive.

Jump Rope for Heart

Jump Rope for Heart was also a great success this year, with the school raising approximately \$3200, about \$500 more than the previous year with 30 less students and receiving a kick back of \$300. Top fundraisers this year were Samantha Strench with \$275 funds raised, followed by Brant Figura and Violet Quinn with \$250 raised each.

Bottle Depot Account

Leath Strench has set up an account with the Mount Boucherie Regional Bottle Depot on Kyle Road that will credit the PAC refunds for any bottles returned on behalf of the group. The account number is #168.
